1. *Research Overview:* A project description outlining the research question and how the proposed site visits will help in answering this question. This description should include a statement of the scholarly importance of the research. (Not to exceed two pages, 12pt font, double spaced.)
2. *Project Plan:* A statement explaining the planned on-site activities and how these activities will contribute to answering the proposed research question. The plan should include an overview of the travel plan and budget. (Not to exceed two pages, 12pt font, double spaced.)
3. *Experience Statement:* A statement of the applicant's prior experience and qualifications supporting his or her ability to conduct the proposed research. Prior experience would be expected to include either experience in conducting related interviews and/or experience in researching the subject for which the interviews are being conducted. Purely exploratory site visits would not typically be funded. (Not to exceed one page, 12pt font, double spaced.)
4. *Related Work:* A journal article or working paper, not to exceed 40 pages. This paper should be on a related research question.
5. *Curriculum vitae.*

The application statements should be brief and should not exceed five pages in total, excluding the application form, c.v. and attached paper. In most cases, the Research Overview, Project Plan, and Experience Statement are expected to require fewer than five pages.
